Spanish architectural visionary here in March

Tickets are still available for the forthcoming Australian talk series by renowned Spanish architect, Anton Garcia-Abril.

Considered one of the bright stars of the European scene, Garcia-Abril is being brought to Australia in March by respected industry organisation, Cement Concrete & Aggregates Australia (CCA), for its second annual C+A talk series.

Garcia-Abril's reputation is built on projects like the SGAE Central Office and the Musical Studies Centre, both in Santiago de Compostela. These projects seemingly buck the trend for lightness and transparency, instead embracing the monolithic nature of materials like concrete.

More recently, his stunning, internationally recognised Hemeroscopium house in Madrid strikes more of a balance - a composition of massive precast concrete and steel truss beams that floats over glass walls.

Garcia-Abril will talk about these and other landmark projects in Perth on March 22, Melbourne on March 24 and Sydney on March 25.
