ACT builders to get 'concrete' answers at seminar

The 'ins and outs' of working with concrete on residential building sites will be covered in a two-hour seminar for builders and contractors in Canberra later this month.

Residential Concrete Solutions: common pitfalls and practical solutions for builders and contractors is being presented by leading industry organisation Cement Concrete & Aggregates Australia (CCA) at Red Hill on **Wednesday November 23**, commencing from 5.30pm.

The seminar is aimed at building professionals - building company owners and construction managers, contractors and tradespersons – and is designed to give an overview of the most effective approaches to using concrete on residential sites to deliver quality results.
